OBSERVER REPORTING - League of Women Voters, Lower Cape Fear

The Brunswick County Board of Commissioners held a regular meeting on July 16, 2018, beginning at 6:00 pm in the Commissioners' Meeting Room of the David R. Sandifer Building in the County Government Center in Bolivia. All commissioners were present including: Randy Thompson, Martin Cooke, Pat Sykes, Mike Forte, Frank Williams. Staff present included the County Manager, Ann Hardy. An <u>agenda</u> was posted prior to the meeting. The Wilmington Star News was present.

Agenda discussion topics relevant to LWV positions/programs:

During the public comment period members of the community expressed their opposition to offshore drilling and seismic testing. They requested the Commissioners pass a resolution to oppose offshore drilling.

The tax administration office presented the 2019 Schedule of Values and requested a meeting be scheduled for its adoption. The commissions approved the scheduled meeting.

There was a public hearing to review the new FEMA flood maps and associated Flood Insurance Rates Maps. Commissioners approved the First and Second Readings of the proposed text amendment to the Unified Development Ordinance for the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance.

The Commissioners approved providing a letter of support to the state for a grant advance of \$1,800,000 for the Cape Fear Regional Jetport to purchase land for additional hangers.

The Commissioners approved a resolution of application by the NC Division of Water (MCDWR) for a grant to dredge an improved navigation channel at the Lockwood Folly Inlet.
