From the President...

The first open enrollment for the ACA is about to close and the number of Americans signed up for health care is growing. As of today, March 27, the enrollment QHPs (qualified health plans) has reached 6 million. Local sign up numbers are not available, but state wide over 300,000 had signed up as of this week. North Carolina has been a surprise mostly because Medicaid was not expanded in our State. There are hundreds of thousands of people in North Carolina that would qualify for Medicaid if our state would have accepted the Federal exchange. Finally, on a personal level, today I had the personal pleasure of watching a young twenty something single mother get help from my husband and me as she found a very affordable health care plan for herself, aided by a government subsidy which made the plan affordable. Those who want to repeal the ACA should put themselves in that young women's shoes before undoing such historic legislation.
